

TURKEY PRINTS

Are you looking for a messy way to have fun with your kids as they get ready for Thanksgiving? **PLAY** with your little one as they make turkey prints.

Materials Needed:

- White Construction Paper
- Brown Construction Paper
- Orange Construction Paper
- Red Construction Paper
- Googly Eyes (Optional)
- Black Marker
- Red Washable Paint
- Yellow Washable Paint
- Brown Washable Paint
- Orange Washable Paint
- Scissors
- Glue
- Paper Plate

How To Create Your Own Turkey Prints:

1. Using your scissors and the brown construction paper, cut out an hourglass shape to represent the turkey's body.
2. Glue the turkey's body to the white construction paper.
3. Using your scissors and the orange construction paper, cut out a triangle to represent the turkey's nose.
4. Glue the triangle on the top half of the turkey's body.
5. Above the turkey's nose, glue two googly eyes to represent the turkey's eyes. If you don't have googly eyes, use a black marker to draw two dots to represent the turkey's eyes.
6. Using your scissors and the red construction paper, cut out a teardrop shape.
7. Glue the teardrop shape to the bottom of the turkey's nose.
8. Put a little of each color of paint on a paper plate.
9. Dip your thumb in the paint to create fingerprints to represent the turkey's feathers.
10. Repeat step 9 many times with all colors to give the turkey a full coat of feathers.
11. Display your turkey prints for all to see on Thanksgiving day!
