

THANKFUL SPINNERS

Are you looking for a fun way to share what your little one is thankful for?
PLAY with your little ones as they create thankful spinners!

Materials Needed:

- White Construction Paper or Cardstock
- Crayons, Markers or Colored Pencils
- Scissors
- A Circle to Trace (Something like a bowl)
- Hole Punch
- Yarn or String

How To Create Thankful Spinners:

1. Trace your circle onto a white piece of construction paper or cardstock.
2. Starting in the center of the circle, help your little one draw a spiral to the outside of the circle.
3. Cut out the circle, leaving the spiral in the middle.
4. Have your little one color the circle however they would like.
5. Along the spiral, help your little one write out all of the things they are thankful for.
6. Tip: It might be a good idea to help your little one create a list before writing them along the spiral.
7. Be sure to decorate both sides of the circle.
8. Carefully cut along the spiral line.
9. Use the hole punch to create a hole at the center of your circle and spiral.
10. Tie a strand of yarn or string to the hole to hang the spiral.
11. Display your thankful spiral for all to see!



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
