



SPATULA PUMPKIN

As the Fall season begins to take off and the pumpkins grow, **PLAY** with your little one as they create a fun, pumpkin painting craft!

Materials Needed:

- Orange Washable Paint
- Green Washable Paint
- Spatula
- Paint Brush
- Black Construction Paper
- White Construction Paper
- Glue
- Scissors

Make Your Own Spatula Pumpkin Painting

1. Dip your spatula in the orange paint.
2. Stamp your spatula on the white piece of construction paper.
3. Have your little one repeat steps 1 and 2 as many times as they would like.
4. Using your paint brush, paint a thick green line at the top of your spatula stamp to represent a pumpkin stem.
5. Repeat step 4 for as many stamps as your little one has decided to make.
6. Cut 2 small black circles for each stamp to represent the pumpkin's eyes.
7. Cut 1 small triangle for each stamp to represent the pumpkin's nose.
8. Cut 1 mouth for each stamp.
9. The mouth of each pumpkin can be different shapes if your little one would like.
10. Glue the eyes, nose and mouth to each stamp once the paint is dry.
11. Enjoy your spatula pumpkin painting!
