



PAPER PLATE Flowers

April Showers bring May Flowers, so what better way to celebrate Spring than by decorating your home with handmade flowers? As you decorate, you can **TALK** with your child about their favorite parts of Spring!

Materials Needed:

- Paper plate
- Glue
- Scissors
- Paint
- Paintbrush

Make a Paper Plate Flower:

1. Paint the entire paper plate with your favorite Spring colors
2. When the paint is dry, help your child cut out the inner circle
3. Chop up the rim of the plate into chunky pieces. These will be your petals!
4. Have your child glue the shorter ends of the petals to the back of the round center
