



# FEED THE SNOWMAN

It's January, which means it's getting even colder outside! This activity is a perfect way for your child to **PLAY** when you're stuck inside on a winter day. It's easy to set up and super cute!

## Materials Needed:

- Plastic cup
- Plastic serving tongs
- Cotton balls
- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue

In addition to being tons of fun, Feed the Snowman also helps your little one with their fine motor skills, hand-eye coordination, problem solving and measurement skills!

## Feed the Snowman:

1. Cut a carrot nose, hat and scarf out of construction paper and glue it onto the cup. Note: While fun, decorating the cup is optional! Your child can have fun feeding the snowman without decorating the cup.
2. Lay out the cotton balls.
3. Instruct your little one to "feed the snowman" by using the tongs to drop the cotton balls into the cup.
