



# JELLYFISH BOWLS!

Do you like the way jellyfish swim in the ocean? Are their tentacles flowy and fun? **PLAY** with your little one as they create a fun, ocean-themed animal!

## Materials Needed:

- Paper Bowl
- Multiple Colors of Construction Paper
- Scissors Glue
- Ribbon (Multiple colors if you and your little one would like)
- White String, Yarn or Ribbon
- Googly Eyes (Optional)
- Black Marker
- Tape

## How to Create Your Jellyfish Bowl:

1. Cut up your construction paper into squares or many different shapes.
2. Turn your paper bowl upside down.
3. Add glue to the cut-up pieces of construction paper.
4. Glue the construction paper to the paper bowl.
5. Wait for your glue to completely dry.
6. Poke a small hole in the top of the paper bowl.
7. Feed a piece of white string, yarn or ribbon into the hole and tie a knot at the end to hold it in place.
8. Put tape on top of the hole and the string, yarn or ribbon to make sure it won't fall.
9. Cut your ribbon (possibly multiple colors) into long strands.
10. Tape one end of each of the strands of ribbon onto the part of the bowl without the construction paper (the inside of the bowl).
11. Glue your googly eyes to the construction papered bowl to give your jellyfish a bowl. If you don't have googly eyes, draw two dots with a black marker to represent the eyes.
12. Have fun with your new jellyfish!
