

TISSUE PAPER Rainbow

We are over the rainbow excited for summer! Through this activity, kids can create their own rainbow to catch the sun. This is a great way to **PLAY** with your little one as you **TALK** about the colors of the rainbow.

Materials Needed:

- Multiple colors of tissue paper (Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue, Violet)
- Scissors
- Wax paper
- Clear tape
- Glue (Clear drying if possible)
- Cotton balls (or cotton that can be rolled into balls)

How to Make Your Own Rainbow:

1. Cut your tissue paper into many small squares, around 1in by 1in in size. You can also cut other shapes to make the rainbow more unique.
2. Cut your wax paper to a larger size than you want your rainbow to be.
3. Draw 6 curved lines with glue in the shape of a rainbow on the left side of your wax paper.
4. Place your tissue paper shapes on the glue in the order of the rainbow colors. The order from top to bottom should be red, orange, yellow, green, blue and violet. Make sure there isn't any blank space on the glue lines.
5. Add glue to the bottom right side of your rainbow to make a cloud.
6. Place your cotton balls on the glue to look like a cloud. If your cotton balls aren't sticking well, try pulling them apart to make them thinner.
7. Once all of the glue is dry, cut the extra wax paper from around the rainbow and cloud.
8. Place tape on the back of the rainbow.
9. Place your rainbow on the window and wait for the sun to shine through!
