

RAIN CLOUD AND Raindrop Craft

April showers bring May flowers, but while you're waiting for the rain to end, here's a fun way for you and your child to **PLAY** inside!

Materials Needed:

- Blue construction paper
- White construction paper
- Yellow construction paper
- Cotton balls
- Glue stick
- Yarn
- Tape

Make a cloud with raindrops:

1. Cut a cloud shape out of the white construction paper, several raindrop shapes out of the blue paper, and a sun out of the yellow paper.
2. Cut a few strands of yarn that are different lengths and glue the tips of the yarn to the back of the cloud.
3. Tape the raindrops to the yarn.
4. Tape or glue the yellow sun behind the white cloud.
5. Add a generous amount of glue to the front of the white cloud and add cotton balls to make it fluffy!

For an extra challenge, **TALK** to your child about springtime and things that remind them of spring. Write each of these words on one of the raindrops.
